

FR. FRANK SREBERNAK SCHOLARSHIP

St. Paul The Apostle Church, Calumet

1. Student Eligibility

To be awarded to any graduating catholic senior, who plans to pursue advanced education or training and who meets the following criteria:

- A. Is a member of one of the local catholic churches; St. Paul the Apostle-Calumet, Sacred Heart-Calumet, Our Lady of Peace-Ahmeek, Holy Redeemer-Eagle Harbor, Our Lady of the Pines-Copper Harbor.
- B. Is actively involved in church related activities.
- C. Is enrolled in a college, university, or trade school.

2. Student Responsibilities:

- A. The student will be responsible for completing an application form and essay. PDF versions of necessary forms may be obtained from St. Paul the Apostle parish office by e-mailing the parish secretary Jan Jurmu (stpauls@chartermi.net). It can also be downloaded at the following URL.

- B. The completed application must be submitted to Jan Jurmu by 1:00 pm on Friday, May 2nd, 2008.*
- C. Successful applicants will be required to complete and submit a progress report by May 31st of the year following their award. This report should summarize progress during the previous academic year, and discuss future goals.

3. Selection of Candidate:

- A. Applicants will be judged on the basis of scholarship and service to their church and community.
- B. The Pastor of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church and the Pastoral Council Scholarship committee members will select and notify the winning candidate(s).

4. Payment of Award:

The recipient(s) will receive the scholarship award after providing proof of registration and enrollment at a college, university, or trade school to St. Paul the Apostle Scholarship committee.

5. Fund Account:

The funds for the scholarship will be devised based on an account established in Fr. Srebernak's name. The Pastor of St. Paul the Apostle church in Calumet will monitor the scholarship fund. The monetary award(s) will reflect yearly funds available.
